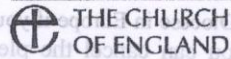

Notes:

- (1) Please notify the Diocese in Europe of any change in your name or address while this form is still in force. You must also notify the Diocese in Europe of any change in your pledge at any time by notifying the Diocese in Europe - it will then not apply to donations you make on or after the date of such later date as you specify.
- (2) You must pay an amount of UK income tax and/or capital gains tax at least equal to the tax that the Diocese in Europe claims on your donations in the tax year (currently 28p for each £1 you give).
- (3) If in the future your circumstances change and you no longer pay UK tax on your income/capital gains you can claim further tax relief in your Self Assessment tax return (see note 1).
- (4) If you pay at the higher rate you can claim further tax relief in your Self Assessment tax return.
- (4) If you are a resident of the Diocese in Europe you can ask your local tax office for leaflet IR17 Off Air.
